Exam Fee:

A fee of £150.00 will be charged to cover the costs of administering this examination. This will cover the full Accreditation process, INCLUDING assessment of the practical cases, together with Proficiency Registration, Certificate and Badge for successful candidates.

Those who are unsuccessful on the written assessment will have to pay a further £75 to re-sit the exam at a later date, within 12 months of unsuccessful attempt.

Payment in full is required at the time of registration. If your Trust is paying for you to attend the exam you are advised to send a personal payment with your registration form and to claim the fees back with the receipt that we will send you.

Exam eligibility:

BSE Proficiency Accreditation is available **ONLY TO MEMBERS OF THE BSE**. You must be a current member at the time of registration and maintain your membership during the Accreditation process. Anyone wishing to obtain Accreditation who is not already a member must first join the Society. Membership Forms can be processed on-line at www.bsecho.org. The current annual subscription fee is £60.00.

Exam places are allocated on a *first come, first served* basis, regardless of how long you have been a member of the BSE.

Exam Registration Closing Date:

The closing date for registrations is **Friday 28th September 2012**.

Please note that there is limited availability at the exam location and it may reach full capacity before the closing date.

Cancellations:

If you cancel your exam place **before the registration closing date**, an administration fee of £15.00 will be deducted from your refund.

Cancellations **received after the registration closing date** will only be refunded (minus £15.00 admin fee) if there is a waiting list candidate able to take the place.

Personal Property:

BSE accepts no liability for the loss of belongings whilst at the exam venue.

You will only be permitted to bring a pencil, eraser, calculator, bottle of water and sweets to your desk.
